

Attention horsemen planning to race at the 2017 Crawford County Fair:

Although there is a note concerning this matter in the fair book, I wanted to just remind everyone and explain the situation a little better.

Race Horse Barn #1 (older barn): This barn has a total of 60 stalls. Most of these stalls will be available to ship ins at the start of the fair (August 19). If any of these stalls must be used to house the draft horses overflow, they will be available immediately after the draft horse competition on the evening of Tuesday, August 22 around 10pm.

Race Horse Barn #2 (bigger barn): This barn has a total of 73 stalls, however, we will be sharing them with the draft horses for the week. *NONE of these stalls will be available before Wednesday morning, August 23.* Approximately 40 stalls in this barn will become available by 9:00 am Wednesday. We are going to have people on hand and ready to clean out each stall as soon as it is vacated by a draft horse.



PLEASE, be patient with us during the ship in process on Wednesday morning. We realize that there may be some traffic congestion. We will be doing our best to accommodate everyone. If anyone would like to let me know what day and time they plan to ship in, I will try to assign stalls based on those schedules, as well as the draft horse people's schedules. I will be on the grounds early Wednesday morning to move the drafts' departures along as quickly as possible. We do have some flexibility on post time and if things take longer than expected during this process, we can, but only if necessary, push post time back.



ONE FINAL REMINDER: Please do not attempt to ship into the fairgrounds between Noon and 10pm on Tuesday, August 22. The entire area will be closed to accommodate the North American Six-Horse Hitch Classic Series. Please respect the guidelines and plan accordingly.
